Fund Description

The Market Vectors Agribusiness ETF seeks to replicate as closely as possible, before fees and expenses, the price and yield performance of the Market Vectors Global Agribusiness Index. The Index is intended to track the overall performance of companies involved in: (i) agri-chemicals, animal health and fertilizers, seeds and traits, (ii) farm/irrigation equipment and farm machinery and/or (iii) agricultural products (including grain, tobacco, meat, poultry, and sugar), aquaculture and fishing, livestock, plantations, and trading of agricultural products.

Averages are market weighted. Price/Book Ratio is the price of a security divided by the book value per share of the security. Market Capitalization of an individual, publicly traded company is calculated by multiplying the company's stock price by the total number of its shares outstanding. 30-Day SEC Yield is a standard calculation developed by the Securities and Exchange Commission that allows for fairer comparisons among funds. It is based on the most recent 30-day period and reflects the investment income earned after deducting a fund's expenses for the period.
