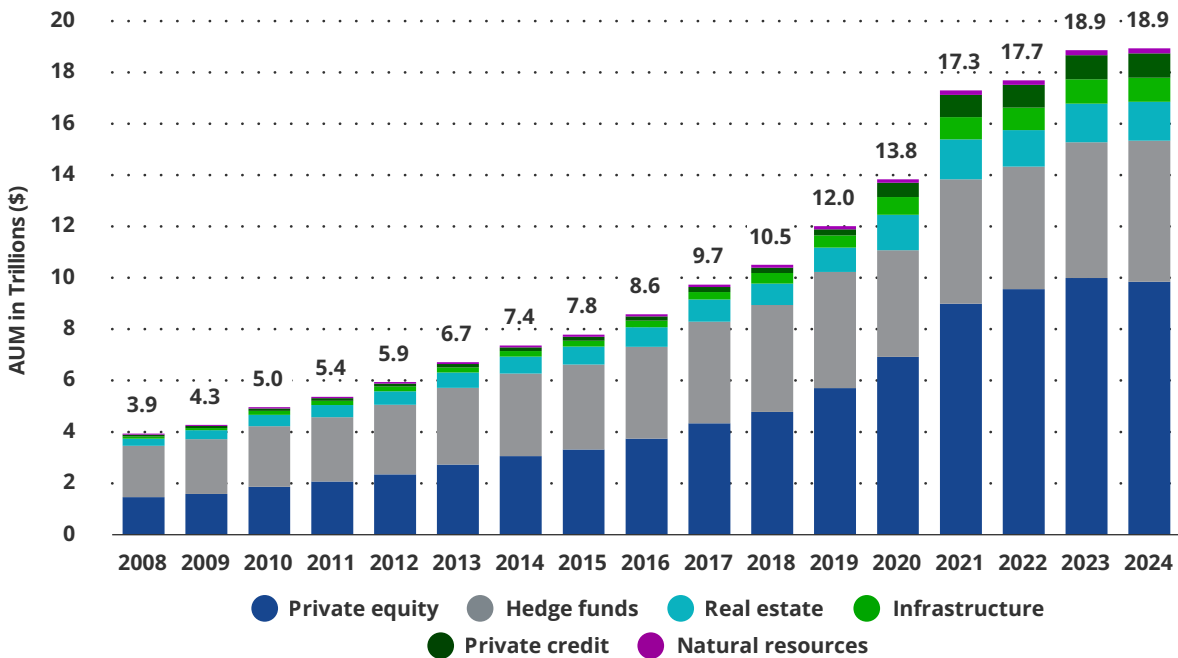

Growing Global Alternative Assets Under Management / as of 6/30/2024

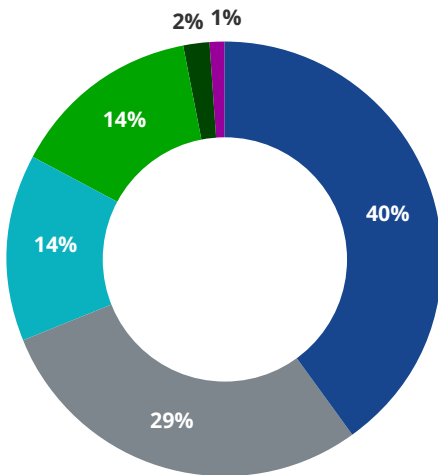

Long-term investments in physical assets like transportation, energy, utilities, and digital infrastructure. These assets often provide stable, inflation-linked cash flows.	Direct investment in commercial or residential property, often through private funds. Focuses on income from rents and capital appreciation from asset management and development.
